## Uniform

Being Talavera Smart is important in helping your child understand their role and responsibility at our school. Here is a guide to our uniform. If you need support with your child's uniform, we are here to help. We have spare shoes available if needed.



Red school jumper (can be branded from Edgar Jerome)  
White polo shirt  
Black skirt, shorts or trousers  
Leggings are not school



Indoor PE: red or white t-shirt (plain or Talavera-branded) and black shorts

Outdoor: as above, with red or black jumper. Leggings or tracksuit bottoms can be worn.

A quick reminder: hair accessories need to be small and plain, matching the school colours. If hair is long enough to be put up, it should be tied up for the school day.



Children can wear one set of stud earrings—no hoops or other jewellery.

## Attendance

Please be reminded that we work hard to ensure that Every Learning Minute Counts. We work at a fast pace as a school and, as a result, your children make great progress and achieve strong outcomes.

However, we have seen an increase in the number of people taking days off from school, either for extended holidays or for occasional events.

These **significantly** impact your child's education.

Please be advised that parents/ carers may be fined or subject to a Legal Intervention Team if attendance becomes a particular concern.

## Car Park

Due to unforeseen circumstances, the building work at the front of the school will be continuing into the new year. Therefore, until further notice, drop off and pick up for Year 3 will remain as followed:

- Blue Whales will need to be dropped off and picked up from Axolotls
- Green Turtles will need to be dropped off and picked up from Emperor Penguins

As before, we understand that this may cause delays to collection and, for this reason, the affected Year 3 classes will open their doors to dismiss from 3:15pm.
