communities If your family is in receipt of Free School Meals or if you match a number of other criteria such as specific benefits, you should be eligible for support over the summer holidays. This could be a sports club, drama event, something crafty or something else entirely.

Step 1 - have you registered? To book a benefit-related FSM HAF place, you must first register with Hampshire County Council to receive a unique code that your activity provider will require when you book with them. Providers will not be able to accept your booking without this code. Other families may be able to access a HAF scheme at the providers discretion. Registration is not required under providers discretion.

We know that the summer holidays are long and can be a period of stress for families. If you know that you need help for your own mental health, please access one of the services listed by the NHS:



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
