The Longest yarn – Royal Garrison Church – 1st November till 18th November

The Longest Yarn is an 80-meter, 3D depiction of the D-Day Landings on June 6, 1944, created in wool art. It consists of 80 displays, each measuring one meter in length, depicting scenes of the world's largest amphibious invasion and is something quite unique and not to be missed. Aldershot was one of the centres for the build-up of forces for D-Day so it is poignant that the exhibition will be with us over the period of remembrance.
