Children should come to school wearing their P.E. kit all week. However, if you would prefer them to wear long trousers, due to the nature of this activity, they may do so.

### **Invitation to Year 6 production – tickets on Arbor**

This is a reminder that our Year 6 production of *The Wizard of Oz* is fast approaching and we are very excited to welcome you to what promises to be a fantastic performance!

As you know, every child in Year 6 is involved in the production, whether they have a speaking part, are in the chorus or helping behind the scenes. Your child will be able to tell you what their role is but if you have any questions, please do get in touch.

There are two performance options and you can confirm attendance for up to **three guests per child** via **Arbor**:

- **Afternoon Performance:** Tuesday 15th July - doors open at 13:30 for a 13:45 start (finishing around 15:00).
- **Evening Performance:** Wednesday 16th July - doors open at 17:45 for an 18:00 start (finishing around 19:15).

Please note that, as all children are involved in the play, all children will be required to attend **both the evening and afternoon** performance. For the evening performance, we kindly ask that children arrive at school between 17:00 and 17:30. They will need to be picked up by an adult once the performance has finished and will not be able to walk home alone.

If you are attending the **afternoon show**, you are welcome to take your Year 6 child home once the performance has finished and they have changed out of their costumes.
