



### Talavera School Pupil Internet Agreement

At Talavera we expect all pupils to be responsible for their own behaviour on the Internet.

*Therefore in order to use the Internet at our school, please read the following rules to your child and ensure they understand and agree to them.*

You must:

- ask an adult before accessing the Internet
- tell a teacher as soon as you encounter any inappropriate or unsuitable material
- not download any programs or files from the Internet
- not deliberately seek out offensive materials
- use polite language when speaking to any other students online
- only contact people who have been approved by your teacher

Please also note that when your child completes their homework it can be emailed to the office ([office@talaverajunior.co.uk](mailto:office@talaverajunior.co.uk)). Please do not bring in on a disc or memory stick unless agreed prior.

Finally at Talavera we take great care to ensure our children remain safe online and for this reason we ask that you maintain these rules whilst at home. If you do have any questions or concerns regarding Internet safety at home please contact Miss Coombs, Computing Manager.

## **Responsible Use of the Internet**
